

Union Bay Improvement District
Bylaw # 201
Amending Bylaw for Bylaw #186
Fire Department Establishment and Operations Bylaw

A bylaw to amend Bylaw No. 186, being the Fire Department Establishment and Operations Bylaw.

The Trustees of the Union Bay Improvement District ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the improvement district's Bylaw No. 186, passed by the Trustees on the 12th day of May, 2004, is hereby amended by deleting sections 2, 7 and substituting the following:
 2. There is hereby established a fire department to be known as the Union Bay Improvement District Volunteer Fire Department. The said department shall consist of at least 10 members and not more than 30 members, provided, however, that this number may be varied from time to time at the request of the Fire Chief and approval of the Board.
 7. The Fire Chief has complete responsibility and authority over the fire department subject to the direction and control of the Board to which he shall be responsible and in particular, he shall be required to carry out all fire protection activities, assistance response and such other activities as the Board directs including, but not limited to:
 - a. Fire Suppression
 - b. First Responder
 - c. Fire and Rescue Services Agreement – Comox Valley
 - d. Public service
2. This bylaw may be cited as the "Bylaw No. 201 Amending Bylaw #186".
